***THE SIGN TAG PERMIT FEES ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

\$1.00 FOR EACH ADVERTISING FACE (EACH SIGN FACE REQUIRES AN SHA SIGN PERMIT TAG)

All sign permits and licenses expire on April 30th each year. All renewal fees must be paid May 1st. After October 1st, the Administration may remove a structure for which the renewal fee is not paid, according to Sections 8-748 & 8-749, of the Annotated Code of MD. Sign owners are also responsible for any removal costs incurred by SHA.

Section 8-708, of the Annotated Code of MD., requires anyone erecting, maintaining, or leasing outdoor advertising signs along a state highway, to also obtain an SHA Outdoor Advertising License. There is no charge for this license.

All out of state license and permit holders must file a \$1,000.00 surety bond with the State Highway Administration. The insurance company must send the original copy directly to SHA. Copies of the bond are not accepted!

Transfer of Sign Ownership: The sign owner must notify SHA through notarized documentation if the sign transfers ownership in the future. All parties must sign and agree to the transfer of the tag(s) and ownership.

Any person who violates any provision of Sections 8-701 thru 8-749 is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine of \$500.00.

Section 8-721, of the Annotated Code of MD. requires that the name and post office address of the person, firm or corporation owning any billboard or structure of other advertisement or controlling the same for advertising purposes, shall be plainly inscribed thereon. In addition, the sign owner must notify SHA within 30 days, if the landowner changes in the future. Signs or other structures used for advertising purposes must plainly display metal permit tag issued by SHA on road side of structure. (60 days from date of this approved application, the sign(s) must be erected and SHA sign permit tag(s) attached. No sign may be erected prior to application approval.

No signs or advertising is permitted within or overhanging the State Right of Way Limits or property.

All signs or advertising locations must be approved by SHA prior to erection. In addition, all sign upgrades and relocations must be approved by SHA. **All location surveys expenses are the responsibility of the sign permit applicant.**

This application does not apply to Interstates/Expressways, where no advertising which is visible is permitted, except certain real estate, on-premise signs and historical markers which are permitted when approved, prior to erection by the State Highway Administration. Off-premise outdoor advertising signs are prohibited on some designated MD scenic byways.

No application for the issuance of sign permit tags will be considered by the State Highway Administration covering the erection of any billboard, structure, sign, poster or display advertising of any kind or nature whatsoever along the State Highway System and within County zoned areas; unless the erection thereof has been approved by the local Zoning Board of the County/City involved and the location thereof has been approved by the ORE Inspector and the Chief, of the Special Acquisitions Division, Office of Real Estate. Responsibility for securing these approvals rests with the applicant.

All site plans shall be carefully and competently prepared, and show the following:

1. All Property lines.
2. Road right-of-way lines.
3. Set back from right-of-way lines.
4. Location of structure on site. (Global Positioning System (GPS) location – if available)
5. Indicate all other off-premise advertising signs on the site.
