How many SHA districts are there in Maryland, and what areas do they cover?

There are seven SHA districts with 28 maintenance shops in Maryland.

- [District 1](#) includes the counties of Dorchester, Wicomico, Worcester and Somerset.
 - [District 2](#) includes the counties of Cecil, Kent, Queen Anne's, Caroline and Talbot.
 - [District 3](#) includes the counties of Montgomery and Prince George's.
 - [District 4](#) includes the counties of Baltimore and Harford.
 - [District 5](#) includes the counties of Anne Arundel, Calvert, Charles and St. Mary's.
 - [District 6](#) includes the counties of Allegany, Garrett and Washington.
 - [District 7](#) includes the counties of Carroll, Frederick and Howard.
