The State Highway Administration (SHA) is pleased to forward its Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance status report to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). This letter highlights SHA's accomplishments and efforts for calendar year 2022.

The SHA reconstructed approximately a mile of sidewalk to meet ADA compliance through the Sidewalk Reconstruction for Pedestrian Access program under Fund 33. In the attached report it reflects a project was completed in Talbot County through this program. As of December 31, 2022, the SHA achieved the ADA compliance for the following areas along our state roadway system:

Feature	Percent Compliant
Sidewalk	71.32
Curb Ramps	68.59
Bus Stops	71.42
Driveway Crossings	61.61
Medians	88.29
