About TAC

Tourist Area and Corridor (TAC) Signage program is a system of supplemental guide signs along roadways providing directions to eligible attractions that provide recreational, historical, cultural or leisure activities to the public.

How It Works

Signs direct motorists to eligible individual attractions in a designated geographical area. Each area has a defined roadway corridor to provide access to the attractions within.

Costs

- New attraction must cover all costs for design, fabricating and installing the signs.
- Annual administration fee of \$1,000.
- Non-refundable application fee of \$500 due when the application form is submitted.
