
TOWN CREEK – HISTORIC BRIDGE AVAILABLE Project Announcement | October 2024



The Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration (SHA) intends to replace Bridge No. 0104700, which carries MD 51 over Town Creek east of Oldtown in Allegany County. The bridge is available to any city, county government, historic preservation organization, bicycle/trail group, other nonprofit organization, corporation, or individual for reuse at a new location.

The recipient party will be responsible for relocating the bridge and will be required to preserve and maintain the bridge in accordance with established standards for historic bridges.

This National Register of Historic Places-eligible bridge was constructed in 1932 by the Roanoke Iron and Bridge Works for the Maryland State Roads Commission. The bridge is a steel, two-span, Pratt through truss design on concrete abutments and pier. The two spans are identical, and the overall length is 210.5 feet. The bridge is 29.33 feet wide from the centerline of the trusses.



Parties interested in reusing this bridge must contact SHA by January 20, 2025.
