## NEW AND REVISED SPECIFICATIONS

## **PURPOSE**

To issue revised specifications documents and new Special Provisions Inserts (SPIs) to the July 2024 State Highway Administration (SHA) Standard Specifications for Construction and Materials. These updates are listed below.

Advertised contracts must issue an addendum to incorporate these updated specifications, replacing the previous Proposal Form Packet (PFP) with the new version.
